

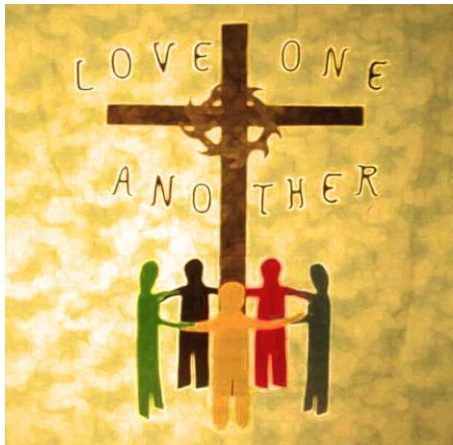
Responding to Collective Worship at Home
