

Responding to Collective Worship at Home

The Theme for Collective Worship this half term is:

Service

Reflecting on the symbol of Hands.

This half term we will be thinking about Service. Jesus exemplified in His person, ministry and relationship with God, what it was to be called the 'Servant King'. Christians believe that their calling is to follow Jesus' example according to their gifts or abilities. We will also be thinking about Advent and Christmas. The word 'advent' means 'coming', and it is at this time that Christians prepare themselves quietly and thoughtfully for the coming of Jesus as a baby. The word 'Christmas' is made up of two words – 'Christ', which is another name for 'Jesus', and 'mass', which means 'celebration'.
